



It is with great pleasure I can announce some of our headline GCSE figures for 2016-17. Our GCSE pass rate of **70%** (4 and above in Maths and English) is well above local and national averages. The figure also represents an increase on the 2015-16 outcomes.

76% of pupils gained a grade 4 or better in Maths.

80% of pupils gained a grade 4 or better in English.

Both of the figures above represent an increase on previous years and are significantly above local and national averages. The table below shows are performance relative to previous years and national averages. We are delighted with the comparisons.
