We have created a DJ booth and Vocal Room and have been very fortunate in securing a set of Pioneer DJ decks for the pupils to use in Music.

From September, we will be able to offer individual DJ and Music Production lessons. Our Music Production teacher, Mr Wait, is an award-winning producer and Music Technology specialist.

These lessons allow pupils to learn how to DJ on professional equipment and how to use music software to produce and compose Music. The new GCSE Music syllabus allows DJing as a performance option for the practical work, which could be suitable for pupils who do not sing or play an instrument. It could also be a valuable experience for instrumentalists and singers to develop additional skills in this field, preparing them for a career in the contemporary music industry.
