

Emerson Park Academy - Deciding what to do after you've got your results

Do my grades affect my decisions about what to do next in education? And do I think an error has been made with my grade?

No – I can progress as intended or look for a new option that I am happy I can progress with.

Yes – contact us by email at exams@emersonparkacademy.org stating your full legal name, Candidate number, subject and paper (example: Jasper Thomas/ 7856/Geography paper 2) and the reason for your email. You may want to say that you are one mark away from the next grade boundary or that you feel an error has been made with the grade.

In the first instance, we may recommend that you request a copy of your script (Access to Script – ATS, service A1) so that you can make an informed decision on whether you want to proceed with a 'post result' service such as a 'clerical check' (service R1) or a 'review of marking' (service R2, or R2a) and pay the fees.

The deadline to request a copy of your script (service A1) is Thursday 3rd September 2026. Free of charge.

The deadline for a clerical check and review of marking is Friday 18th September 2026. Fees apply.

If you do request a copy of your script, we will email this to you as soon as it is provided by the awarding body. This is usually one or two days.

We are unable to submit any post results services without the exam candidates written consent. We cannot accept consent, or emails from the parent/guardian/carer. Requests that are not emailed and signed from the candidate will not be processed.

If we agree it is worth checking your grade, by submitting a clerical check or review of marking, we will ask you to complete a form to allow us to submit this 'post results' service. The awarding bodies charge fees for these services.

Post results service requests will only be actioned upon receipt of the correctly completed form via email to exams@emersonparkacademy.org or by hand to the main office.

Requests for post results services that attract a fee (anything other than a copy of your script - deadline 3rd September) will not be processed until the fee is paid and form received.

ALL REQUESTS MUST be submitted by the specified deadlines. If a deadline is missed, your request cannot be processed.

The window to make enquiries and submit your form and fees is a short one, so please act as soon as possible.

As a result of a 'clerical check' or 'review of marking', your grade may go up, go down or remain the same
