What is *Community Parenting*?

Lifeline Projects' new Community Parenting programme is the next step for Parent Carer Champions across London to grow their skills, build confidence, and step into community leadership roles.

Our Community Parenting programme is a *free 12-week course* designed to help you grow your skills, build confidence, and step into community leadership roles. You will develop practical skills, enhancing your employment opportunities and personal wellbeing, to become a peer supporter and mentor for your children and/or wider community.

What do I get?

Participants will receive an *OCN Level 2 Award in Peer Mentoring* upon successful completion of the course. A Level 2 Award is equivalent to one GCSE.

How does it work?

You'll need to complete the full 12-session course with us.

You'll have the option of taking all 12 sessions entirely online or as a hybrid of online and in-person sessions held in a region of London near you.

All sessions are delivered by our experienced trainer, Safiyya, and personalised support will be offered throughout your journey.

Who is it for?

While the course is centered around supporting parents, a wide range of topics are covered and many other roles can benefit from this learning, including: *faith leaders, community hubs, community leaders, teachers, and support workers.*

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
